## Devotion

Chris opened the meeting at 6:05 PM. Marv led a devotion and prayer. The devotion was in reference to Richard Rohr's Daily Meditation and the interpretation of the Beatitudes as a call for action, rather than a passive acceptance.

## Secretary's Report

The October 2025 minutes were referenced as being emailed to all parties. Sally motioned to accept the Secretary's Report, and Sue seconded it. Motion carried.

## Treasurer's Report

Jerri presented the Treasurer's Report for October. Marv motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report, and Chad seconded it. Motion carried.

## Pastor's Report - Pastor Karen

Pastor Karen shared activities from the past month, including the Celebration of Life for Shirley Yoder, the monthly breakfast, a visit to Phyllis Tubbs, and preparations for Advent.

## Ministry Area/ Council Liaison Reports

Long Range (Chris): Gutters and brickwork for the pavilion tabled until spring.

Fellowship (Sue), Worship and Music (Absent), Personnel (Chad), Stewardship (Jerri), Pastoral Advisory (Juan, Sally, Chris H.), Cemetery (Marv), and Evangelism (Jerri): Nothing to report.

Social Ministry (Sally): November is World Hunger (HUB and ELCA) and December is Angel Tree

Property (Marv): Picnic tables are cabled, Steve H. is taking the mower for service, the old church is lockable and secure, and the cross lighting is being evaluated.

Finance & Audit (Marv): 2026 budget now has "Ministry to Supply Pastor."

Nominating (Juan Davila, Lana Stutsman): Voting for council members on 11/16/25. Fourteen people will be required for a quorum.

Christian Education (Sue): Sunday School is going well for the little kids. Chad to inquire about Sheila helping with a few of the older kids.

Technology (Chad): Marv proposed that an Administrative Assistant computer be purchased for less than \$1,000 (make and model shared), and the existing computer will be transferred to Pastor Karen's desk. Sue motioned to approve. Sally seconded. Motion carried.

## Old Business

Clothes Closet (Chris): New drop-off time of 10:00-1:00 on Thursdays may need some review, as some people have had difficulty opening the door. The new occupancy limits have reportedly helped the staff.

The HUB: December donations will be canned fruit. Jerri to share specific details with the congregation.

Elections / Congregational Meeting - mentioned above.

Advent Services: Reminder, the Advent season begins 11/30. Wed services will be held 12/3, 12/10, and 12/17 at 6:30 PM. The Christmas Eve service will be held at 7:00 PM.

## New Business

Reorganizing and Use of Committees: Pastor Karon shared an updated list of committees with bulleted areas of responsibilities, along with a possible participation template. After much discussion about how to improve the committee structure and processes for running the church, Chad agreed to draft a revision to the documents in an effort to capture ideas from our review. This will be submitted to Leslie in time to distribute to all council members for review before our next meeting.


